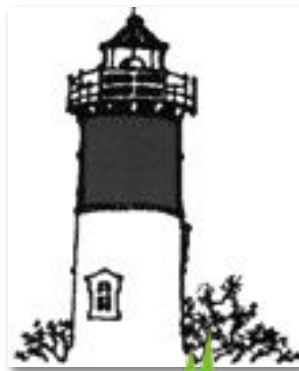

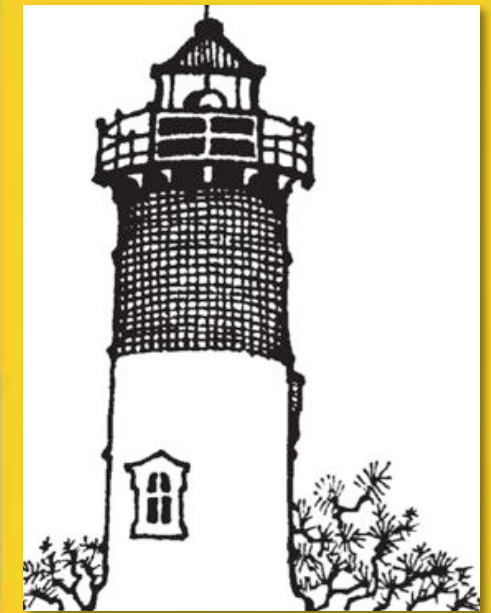

In this week long workshop, teens in grades 6-8 will learn the basics of journaling, which is not the same as keeping a diary. By combining photos and personal memories of their lives on Cape Cod, the teens will create a journal of their experiences and observations. SCRAPBOOKING WORKSHOP

LYWC is a week-long enrichment experience that will bring young writers together to tap creative energies. LYWC is a hands on writing program designed for budding writers by writers. Participants must sign up for either 3 days (\$180) or 5 days (\$280).
