As explained on our website, "Seminars are an integral part of the Lighthouse School philosophy and curriculum. Meeting once a week for 1 ¾ hours a session, the seminars are a way for students and teachers to explore in-depth subjects which might not be covered under the traditional parameters of a middle school curriculum. Each term the seminar offerings change to reflect both the instructional interests of the faculty as well as the learning interests of the students. The seminars also provide a window of opportunity for community members to act as resource partners and sharing in the education of our local students."

Please remember that many factors go into determining a student's placement, such as how many students a seminar can accommodate and what seminars a student has taken in the past. We aim to have our kids take a wide variety of seminars over their tenure at the school, and these multi-graded classes are a great opportunity for students to stretch their comfort zone and get to know different members of our community.
